Importance of implants in stabilisation of oral maxillofacial prostheses

 ${f F}$ acial prostheses act as an alternative treatment for the surgical procedures. Reconstruction of a facial defect prosthetically is a complex and labor requiring process both for the patient and the dentist. Maxillofacial prostheses provide psychological, aesthetic and functional support to the patient. In this case report, implant and eyeglasses retained prosthetic rehabilitation of a nasal defect is described. Retention was provided by using one implant and a magnetic device attached to the eye glasses of the patient due to the failure of other two implants. By using this method patient was able to use the prosthetic nose without any additional surgeries.
