Deltopectoral fl ap for reconstruction of facial defects

The deltopectoral fl ap is beneficial for reconstruction of significant facial defects, off ering up to 250 cm2 of transferable cutaneous tissue to allow reconstruction of the entire facial defects. The deltopectoral fl ap tolerates folding very well and allows movement in wide directions. Th is clinical study was carried out at maxillofacial surgery department at Ramadi Teaching Hospital, Anbar province, Iraq. Acceptable functional as well as aesthetic achievements were obtained and confirmed that deltoopectoral fl ap is good alternative surgical procedure can be applied for the reconstruction of head and neck.
