Kink Affirming Practice- Cultural Competency, Risk Assessment, and Clinical Interventions for BDSM-Identified Clients

The concept of Kink Aware Practice is one that is gaining ground within the Mental Health community. More and more practitioners are seeking out information about BDSM and kink.
