

Cardiovascular aspects of the patients with diabetes

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Abstract

The long-term mortality rate due to cardiovascular disease in patients with type 2 diabetes is higher than the mortality rate from cancer in the general population. Deaths associated with cardiovascular disease in patients with type 2 diabetes. For 24 years, cardiovascular disease has led to 2.5 times more deaths among patients with type 2 diabetes...

Stratification of cardiovascular risk is very important. Very high risks have patients with diabetes and established CVD or with damage to target organs or three or more SS risk factors or early onset of type 1 diabetes with a duration of > 20 years. Most important to put attention at this group of patients in future.
