

Editorial Note for Dentistry-Open Access Journal

For last 10 years, Dentistry is leading the world in publication of peer-reviewed novel research that transforms clinical practice and understanding in Dentistry, Endodontic, Orthodontics, Dental Implants, Prosthodontics, Restorative Dentistry, Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Periodontics, Forensic Dentistry, Digital Dentistry, Minimal Intervention Dentistry, etc and creates a platform for the authors to make their contribution towards the journal. The editorial office promises peer review of the submitted manuscripts for the quality of publishing.

As a member of Publisher International linking Association, PILA, Dentistry is an Open Access (of Longdom Publishing SL) follows the Creative Commons Attribution License and Scholars Open Access publishing policies. It has 25+ Million Readerbase from all around the World.

The Impact factor of Dentistry for the year 2019 was 1.08*. All published articles of this journal are included in the indexing and abstracting coverage of: Index Copernicus, Google Scholar, Sherpa Romeo, Genamics JournalSeek, JournalTOCs, CiteFactor, Ulrich's Periodicals Directory, RefSeek, Hamdard University, EBSCO A-Z, Directory of Abstract Indexing for Journals, OCLC- WorldCat, Publons, Geneva Foundation for Medical Education and Research.

During the calendar year 2019, Dentistry received a total of 36 papers, out of which 18 articles (50%) were rejected in the preliminary quality check due to plagiarism or being out of the format and peer review process. During 2019 around 18 articles were subjected for publication after they are accepted in the peer review process. In the 8 issues of Volume 9 published during the year 2019, a total of 18 articles were published (at an average of 3 articles per issue) of which, articles were published from authors all around the world. A total of 36 research scientists from all over the world reviewed the 18 articles published in volume 9. Average publication lag time of an article was further reduced to 2-3 weeks.

During the calendar year 2020, a total of 2 Editors, 2 Reviewers joined the board of Dentistry and contributed their invaluable services towards contribution as well as publication of articles.

I take this opportunity to acknowledge the contribution of Nobou Kondo during the final editing of articles published and bringing out issues of Dentistry in time. I would also like to express my gratitude to all the authors, reviewers, the publisher, the advisory and the editorial board of Dentistry, the office bearers for their support in bringing out yet another volume of Dentistry and look forward to their unrelenting support to bring out the Volume 10 of Dentistry in scheduled time.
