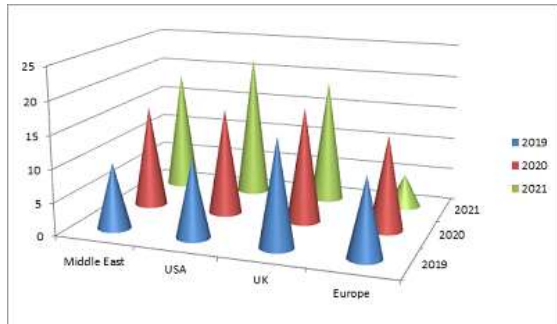
The WHO has also appraised that over 1.3 million community health workers, and making the health care industry one of the largest segments of the
